Procedure Statement

Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi has created a faculty senate as allowed by System Policy *12.04, Academic Council/Faculty Senate*.

Reason for Procedure

This procedure describes the role of the Faculty Senate at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi.

Procedures and Responsibilities

By virtue of its constitution, the Faculty Senate is an advising and recommending body that serves to represent faculty in governance of the university. The Senate's functions include recommending policies (establishment of new policies, changes in existing policies, and interpretation of policy) and advising, reporting, and acting as a forum for discussion and debate of any issue vital to Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi. With regard to academic programs that earn credit, Faculty Senate is one of several university bodies whose approval is necessary (in accordance with University Procedure *11.10.99.C0.01, Development of Academic Degree Programs*) in order for that program, or change in program, to be forwarded to the president for action.

The composition of the Faculty Senate is governed by the constitution of the Faculty Senate.
